During the 2023-2024 school year, Girls Inc. of Orange County provided the following programs to AUHSD students:

INFLUENCEHER

InfluenceHER focuses on digital literacy and online safety with the intention of building the skills to be responsible users of the internet.

CONFIDENCE BoostHER

Confidence BoostHER focuses on self-esteem, mental health support, and promoting healthy identities.

TMI

Trusting My Instincts

TMI focuses on consent, positive communication, and healthy relationships.

SKILLS TO PAY THE BILLS

Skills to Pay the Bills prepares students to be financially independent and knowledgeable about money.

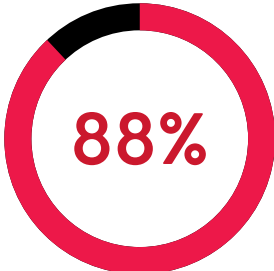

AUHSD + GIOC PROGRAM IMPACT

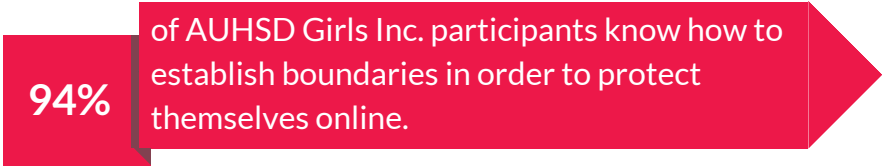

Girls are encouraged to speak up, ask questions, take risks without fear of failure, be open about how they are feeling, and ask for help when they need it. They also develop meaningful relationships with their peers, staff educators, and caring volunteers and mentors.



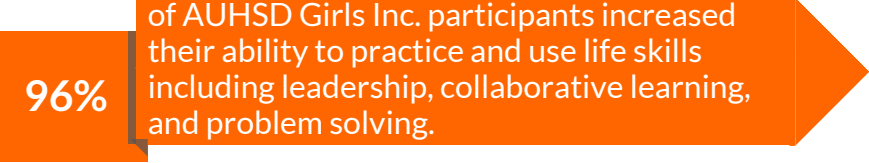
100% of AUHSD Girls Inc. participants feel confident meeting their financial goals.



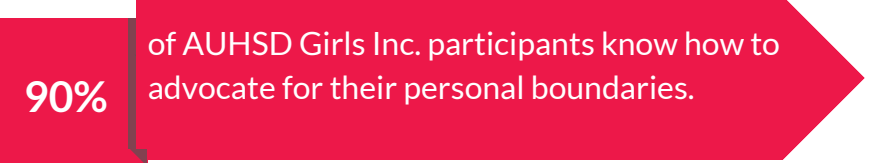
88% of AUHSD Girls Inc. participants reported that Girls Inc. programming boosted their belief in themselves and what they can accomplish.



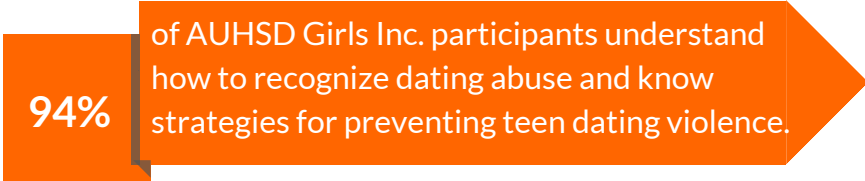
94% of AUHSD Girls Inc. participants know how to establish boundaries in order to protect themselves online.



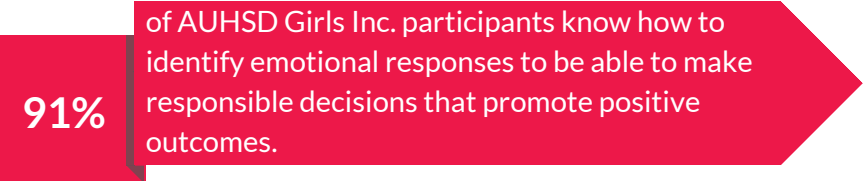
96% of AUHSD Girls Inc. participants increased their ability to practice and use life skills including leadership, collaborative learning, and problem solving.
